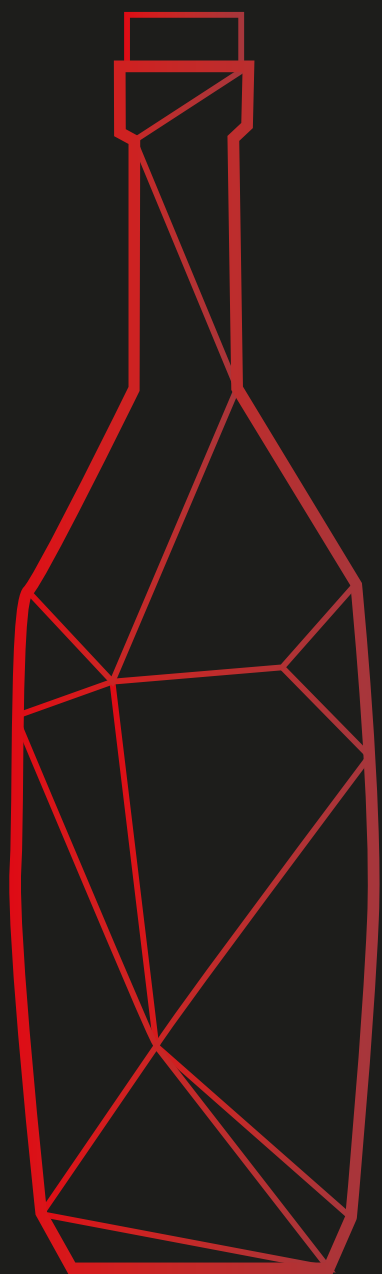

### CHENIN BLANC

A flowery nose and delicate sweetness are traditional characteristics of this fine varietal. In recent years wine makers have begun to make drier chenins, resulting in wine with a beautiful aroma and crisp dry finish.

Beautiful flavours of pomegranate with a mid palate of raspberry. Rich and full bodied in the mouth and great with spicy food.

## PINOTAGE

Cultivated in South Africa in 1925 by Prof. Abraham Perold, this thick skinned grape has flavours of bramble, bananas and tropical fruit.

## CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Cabernet is royalty when it comes to varietals. No matter where in the world it is produced, it makes wines with broad fruit flavours, great depth and character.

## MALBEC

This thick skinned grape needs more sun than merlot or cabernet sauvignon, but when it ripens, it has flavours of plum and develops great complexity, especially in Argentina where it thrives.

## TEMPRANILLO & MENCIA

Spain's noble grape. Grown in the Iberian Peninsula since the time of the Phoenicians, it produces full bodied wines and is the main grape of Rioja.

## MERLOT

Soft, subtle, varietal, it is the only grape used in chateau Petrus and with good reason. This varietal is full of rich flavours and is used as a bonding grape to soften more tannic wines like cabernet sauvignon.

## NEBBIOLO

This grape is an old one, first mentioned in 1266. La Spinetta is certainly distinctive and has a talent for slightly lighter with good acidity and often firm tannins. Winemaking varies, but Nebbiolo does very well with extended post-ferment macerations, sometimes as long as 60-70 days.

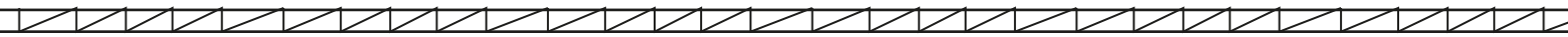
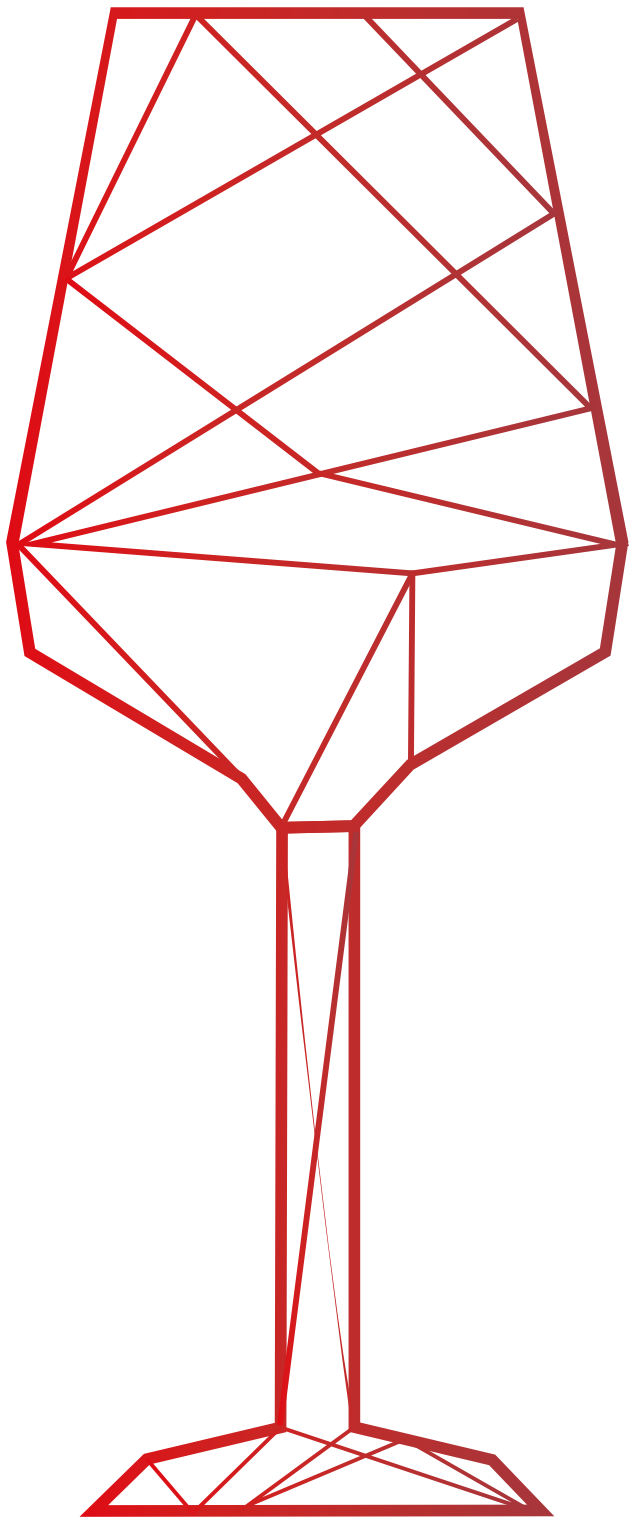
